HOUSE OF DELEGATES GALLERY RULES OF CONDUCT

- The House Chamber and Gallery are regulated pursuant to the Rules, policies, and procedures of the House of Delegates.
- House Gallery seating is limited, and availability is dependent upon the length of the daily session and the number of visitors seeking admittance and is offered on a first-come first-served basis.
- Visitors must remain seated at all times unless otherwise directed by an authorized official.
- Visitors must remain quiet and avoid causing any disturbance. Any outbursts, including cheering, jeering, clapping, or stomping, are prohibited. Do not attempt to communicate with legislators on the floor, either visually or audibly, during a session.
- Visitors must not display any form of sign, banner, or placard in the gallery, lean over the balcony, or place objects on ledges.
- All wireless devices must be turned off or the notification settings placed on vibrate/silent.
- Flash photography, food and beverages, and smoking are not allowed.
- These rules are subject to change by the House of Delegates at any time and without prior notice. All violators are subject to removal.
